

## **FIRST AID REEL & COLLECTOR - 5 COMPETITORS**

### **Dennis Ace Motor Engine , 350 Gallon, First Aid Reel and Collector Event -- 5 Men**

**CONDITIONS.** -- The appliance for this event will be complete with first aid reel and pump and will be situated at a distance of 25 yards from the hydrant. The crew will be seated as indicated in Rules Governing Events. One hundred and twenty feet of 3/4 in. rubber hose will be wound on the first aid reel to which will be attached a controlling nozzle, the nozzle will rest on the top of the reel. The first aid reel hose will be run out a distance of sixty feet (60 feet) to the first branch line and branchman will strike a disc, situated twenty feet (20 feet) from that branch line, with a stream of water so as to operate a light and bell. The striking of the first disc will not be timed. After the disc has been struck the branchman will shut off controlling nozzle. He will then be permitted to assist generally in the Collector evolution. ....

The collector evolution was as for the 350 Gallon Collector, i.e., two lengths rolled hose to be run from hydrants to motor, then two lengths rolled hose connected to deliveries, run out and targets struck.

In 1972 the event was conducted with one flaked and one rolled hose. Four firefighters contested the event. The second disc was timed only.

1974 aggregate times were recorded.

1978 Dennis Ace replaced by Bedford appliance.
