

ALARM AND RESCUE - 1 COMPETITOR

From 1932 Programme

CONDITIONS: Competitors dressed in shirt and trousers to be lying down in a sleeping position with both arms and legs covered. Upon sound of alarm, i.e., fire bell, they shall rise and run 10 yards to where uniform is placed and dress themselves in tunic, cap, light boots or shoes, and belt, axe and spanner. At least three buttons of the coat must be fastened and the belt buckled. A distance of 50 yards shall be run to a position indicated, a dummy figure picked up and carried by the prescribed method a distance of 25 yards. The dummy will represent a male person, arranged so that the weight will be equally distributed, dressed in hat, coat, trousers and boots and the weight not less than 56lbs. The uniform will be arranged by the supervisors in the following manner: Cap will be placed upon the tunic; belt axe and spanner will be placed on the ground at the left of the tunic; boots or shoes on the ground at the right of the tunic. Entries to be restricted to two only from each brigade. This event will be run in heats of four competitors. The winner of each heat only will be eligible to compete in the following rounds.

First Prize: Electric Toaster; Second Prize: Cut Glass Vase; Third Prize: Cut Glass Vase
