Overview	 The Challenge will involve up to 16 teams from NSW Road Crash Rescue providers participating in a number of scenario pits and workshops. The Challenge has a Road Crash Rescue (RCR), Industrial and Domestic Rescue (IDR) and First Aid focus. The Challenge will consist of a Learning Symposium, 2 x RCR scenarios, 1 x Trauma Challenge, 1 x IDR Challenge, 1 x Rescue Skills Challenge, CPR Masterclass and Workshops lead by industry experts. More information is detailed in the Challenge Synopsis included with this EOI. 			
Team Requirements	The team consists of a Team Leader, Medic and 4 members (6 members total) The team can have a reserve who will be able to replace a team member if required. Each team should have a team manager where possible. The Trauma challenge scenarios will only involve two members of the team. The treatment of injuries will be assessed at senior first aid level only. Adequate availability at your station must be maintained. Mixed teams from different stations and agencies can nominate.			
Pre-requisites	It is preferred the members of the team and reserve are Road Crash Rescue Operators accredited by the State Rescue Board but this is not explicitly required. The medic does not require any higher skills than expected at Senior First Aid level.			
Costs of Participation	There is no cost to participate in the Challenge or attend the learning symposium Lunch and refreshments will be provided on site during the symposium and Challenge. Dinner on Saturday Night will be provided as part of the casual function. All travel and accommodation will need to be funded by the respective team. Attendance is voluntary and unpaid.
